Until now, relevant studies have followed disciplinary logics to a large extent, so that a heterogeneous landscape of research has developed. The Research Training Group will discuss these different approaches in the context of the conference and will use a deliberately broad concept of the consequences of social services: In addition to intended outcomes, non-intended consequences of social services will also be considered. Another focus is on the addressees.
